3. The purpose of the data collection is to handle the registration process for the 8th Journal of Private International Law Conference. For this purpose we save your data where necessary for the registration process and keep it for the purpose of your participation in the conference.
The legal basis for the collection and processing of data is Article 6 Section 1 Clause 1 lit. b) of the GDPR.
4. For the purpose of carrying out the registration process your personal data will be shared with the employees of the Chair of Private Law, Private International Law and Comparative Law (Institute for Private International Law, Ludwig Maximilians University Munich).
Any further distribution of your personal data will not be undertaken by us. Your data will be treated strictly confidentially and for the above stated purposes only.
5. As far as your personal data will be electronically processed and saved, the technical functioning of the data processing systems will be carried out by state-run computer centers.
6. We will save your personal data – subject to contrary statutory provisions – until 31 December 2019 at the latest. Your data will be deleted as soon as it is not needed any longer for the purpose of the registration and participation in the conference – subject to any archiving obligation.

7. Furthermore we would like to inform you about your rights in accordance with the GDPR:
- You have the right to get disclosure of your saved personal data (Article 15 GDPR).
 - Should there be processed any wrong personal data, then you have the right to demand correction (Article 16 GDPR).
 - If the legal requirements are met, you can demand deletion or limitation of the processing of your data and/or file an objection against the processing (Article 17, 18, 21 GDPR).
 - You can file complaints at any time with the Bavarian State Data Protection Commissioner to whom you can reach out via the following contact data:
